Port Arthur was an infamous prison which operated from 1830 until 1877. The Port Arthur audio experience aims to enhance your visit to our World Heritage Site. We encourage you to download it to your device either prior to your arrival, or in our Visitor Centre. We also hope it is both informative and entertaining for anyone wanting to know more about this intriguing place and its history.

The Port Arthur Experience is a self-guided audio experience of the Port Arthur Historic Site. Accessible as a podcast in short 5–6-minute episodes that can be streamed or downloaded to your own mobile device.



There is free Wi-Fi accessible in the Port Arthur Visitor Centre.

1. While in the Visitor Centre café or foyer near the ticketing desk, enable Wi-Fi on your device by turning it on in your device settings
2. Look up your available Wi-Fi networks on your device
3. Select TasGov\_Free from the list
4. Accept the terms & conditions
5. Enjoy 30 minutes free Wi-Fi per location per device
