Tasman Room

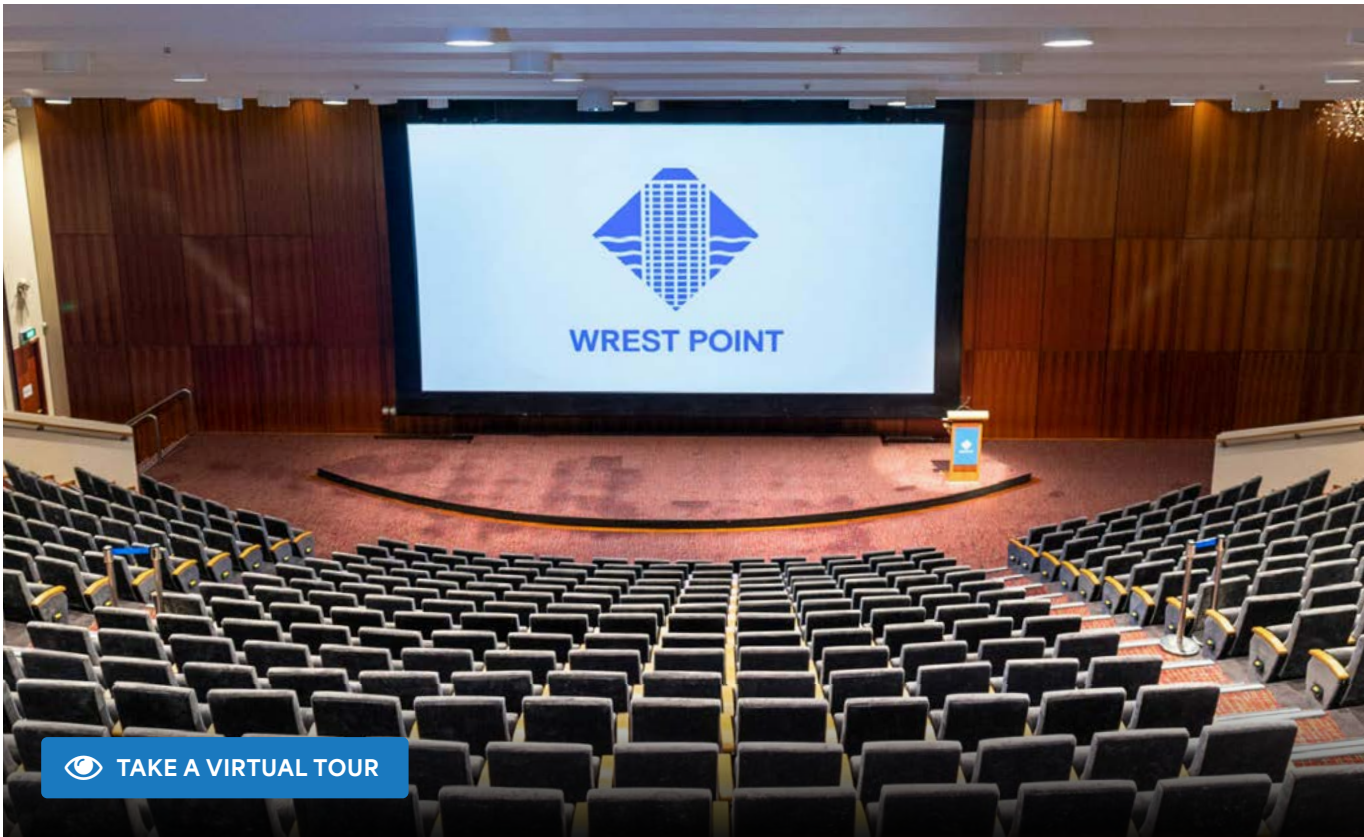


Tasmania’s premier multi-purpose auditorium has played host to many of the state’s most prestigious and memorable events. Featuring a full theatre-style main stage, it comfortably accommodates gala balls, symphonies, business conferences, concerts, shows, dinners, exhibitions, meetings, and functions. For larger events, the Tasman Room can be opened to the Plenary Hall, delivering theatre-style seating for up to 1650 guests.

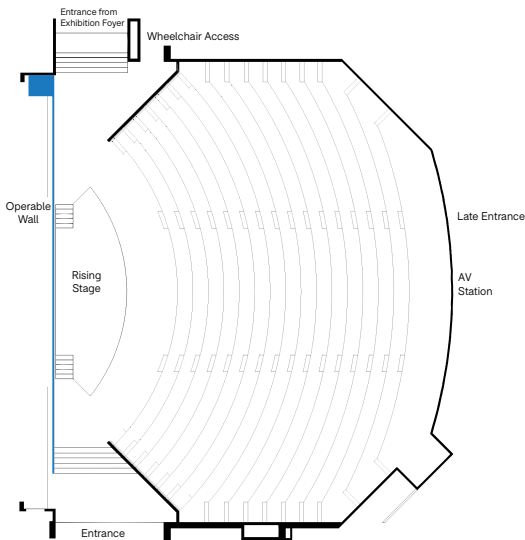

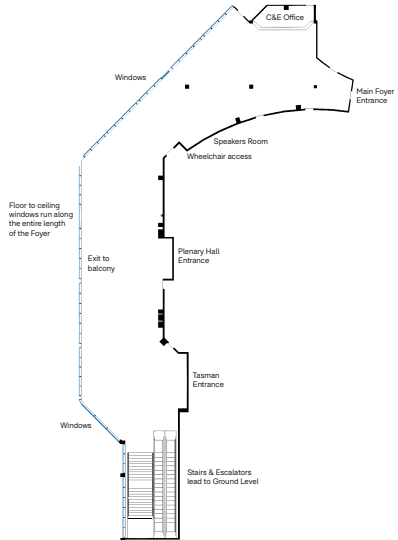

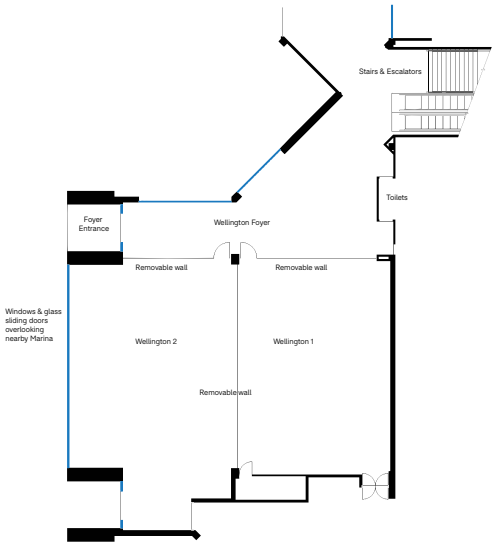

This space can be used with the adjacent foyer and Boardwalk Gallery for larger events.

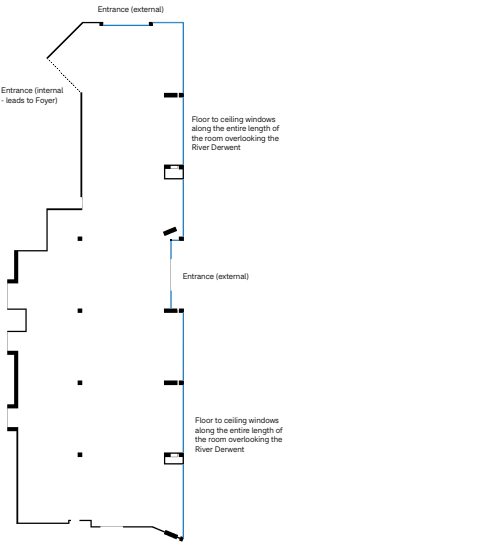

Riviera Room



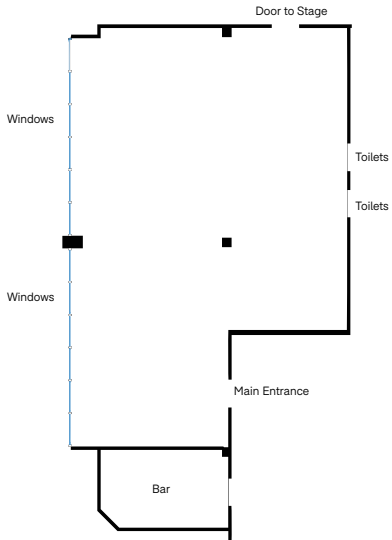
